ADMISSION ELIGIBLITY

AGE CRITERIA

- 1. **Pre-nursery-** minimum age should be **2**years **3**months and maximum age should be **3**years **5**months.
- 2. **Nursery-** minimum age should be **3**years 6 months and maximum age should be **4**years **7**months.
- 3. **K.G-** minimum age should be **4**years **8**months and maximum age should be **5**years **8** months.
- 4. **One-** minimum age should be **5** years **9**months and maximum age should be **6**years **6**months.
- 5. **Two-** minimum age should be **6**years **7**months and maximum age should be **7**years.
- 6. Three- minimum age should be 7 years and maximum age should be 8 years.
- 7. **Four-** minimum age should be **8**years and maximum age should be **9**years.
- 8. **Five-** minimum age should be **9**years and maximum age should be **10**years.
- 9. Six- minimum age should be 10 years and maximum age should be 11 years.
- 10. **Seven-** minimum age should be **11**years and maximum age should be **12**years.
- 11. **Eight-** minimum age should be **12**years and maximum age should be **13**years.
- 12. Nine- minimum age should be 13 years and maximum age should be 14 years.
- 13. **Eleven-** minimum age should be **15**years and maximum age should be **16**years.

Required Documents for Admission:-

- Two colored LATEST passport / stamp size photograph of the child and one each of parents
- Photo Copy of Birth Certificate
- Admission Form
- Self attested copy of Adhar Card of the child
- Self attested copy of blood group of the child (report from authorized lab/certified by MBBS doctor)
- Self attested copy of Adhar Card/voter id card/passport/ration card of both father and mother
- Self attested copy of Caste certificate (in case of SC/ST/OBC only)
- Photo Copy of Report Card / Mark sheet.(if)
- Original copy of Transfer Certificate from the school last attended (class I onwards)

Instructions For Class XI provisional admission: The Registration forms must be accompanied with a self attested photocopy of the mark sheets of Class IX and Pre-Mock/Mock/Half Yearly of Class-X of the respective Schools. Admission Guidelines:-

- The Admission process is transparent.
- Fee must be deposited within the specified time given in the admission offer.
- Non-attendance and /or non-payment of the fee will lead to the cancellation of admission.

Withdrawals Policy

- One calendar months' notice in writing, or a month's fee in lieu of notice must be given before a pupil is withdrawn.
- Exception may be made in case of sudden transfer of Government or Military personnel.
- The transfer certificates for children withdrawn are not issued until all dues are settled.
